

Form I-20 and N.U.in/NU Bound student experience FAQs

Q: When can I register for courses?

A: The process has opened, and you should be able to register for classes now. If you have any issues, please contact your program at nubound@northeastern.edu or nuin@northeastern.edu.

Q: Where will I live?

A: N.U.in students will live with their cohort in one of three residence halls at Mills College @ Northeastern: White, Reinhard and Ege. N.U. Bound students will live with their cohort at Mills College @ Northeastern in either Orchard Meadow or Warren Olney.

Q: How will I get from Mills College @ Northeastern to my classes at the San Francisco regional campus?

A: In addition to receiving a Clipper Card (a pre-loaded pass for the local transportation network), students will travel via a dedicated bus between the San Francisco and Mills College @ Northeastern campuses for their Tuesday and Thursday courses.

Q: What support services are available?

A: Support services you can access include the offerings of our Student Life department, Career Design programming, academic tutoring and writing support, and wellness.

Q: How do I request an I-20?

A: The Office of Global Services (OGS) works with incoming international students on their I-20 process. You can learn more about the process for applying for an I-20 and access the Prearrival I-20 Request E-Form through the [OGS Website](#).

Q: When will my I-20 be issued?

A: We began issuing I-20s on Monday, June 13, 2022. If you have already applied for an I-20, you can expect to receive information from OGS by no later than Wednesday, June 15, 2022.
